We are increasing your rent from Monday, 3 April.

We recognise that any rent rises can be difficult to manage, especially during the cost-of-living crisis.

We have produced this leaflet to explain why we are increasing your rent, and what support is available.

Please contact us if, for whatever reason, you are struggling to pay your rent.


You will not lose your home if you cannot pay your rent, as long as you work with us to manage any arrears you have.

WHY ARE WE INCREASING YOUR RENT?

We are a not-for-profit organisation, and the income we receive from your rent payments is used to provide your services and maintain and build affordable homes.

Unfortunately, high levels of inflation have resulted in an increase in these costs. For example, the price of labour and materials have gone up by between 10% and 15% in the last year, which increases the cost of completing repairs and home improvements such as new kitchens, bathrooms and boilers.

While a 7% increase is below current inflation levels, the rise will support us in providing these services.
